- Volunteer Coordinator**
Contact parents from volunteer list for specific or one time band functions.

- Chaperone Committee**
Accompany and assist the band at competitions and parades.

- Travel and Transportation Committee**
Load (and unload) and transport uniforms, pit equipment, and band instruments to band competitions and parades.

- Uniform Committee**
